The Rumburgh Buck is mentioned in this book, *The Easternmost Sky*, the page marked with a postcard. The postcard shows Sir Alfred Munnings's model 'Shrimp', or Fountain Page, who is related to the Page family who still live in and around All Saints and St Michael.



The Easternmost Sky can be read on its own or as the sequel to *The Easternmost House*, both by Juliet Blaxland, who grew up at The Old Rectory, St Margaret South Elmham as a child of the 1970s and has been there or thereabouts ever since. Although mainly about coastal erosion, these books also contain much of interest about the Saints villages, recognisable people and familiar rural goings-on.

Both books have won awards for non-fiction, nature writing and memoir, placing this little corner of Suffolk gently on the global literary map.
